Internships support the [Digital Munya 2.0](#) project. This is a multidisciplinary effort to visualize an important medieval Islamic building type, landscape setting, and interior furnishings and decoration using the Unity game engine to creatively suggest visual possibilities of these vanished spaces and objects.

Successful applicants may carry out the internship either remotely OR on-site at monuments, heritage sites, and museum collections in Andalucía, Spain and will be supervised remotely by Dr. Glair Anderson, Senior Lecturer in Islamic Art History in the School of History of Art/ECA at the University of Edinburgh. Interns will be expected to present their research to the Digital Lab in the following academic term and to write a short blog post on the research for the Digital Lab's website.

- Demonstrated interest/academic experience in relevant topics, such as medieval Islamic art/ architectural history/archaeology/history; games; digital art; mixed reality
- Demonstrable skills/experience in the aforementioned areas
- Confirmed access to funding to support learning opportunities, such as the University of Edinburgh's [Learning Opportunity Fund](#)
